



## KINDERGARTEN THANKSGIVING

*Kindergarten Thanksgiving* is a popular event that the Beaufort Historical Association holds to help kindergarten students learn how their colonial ancestors prepared for the winter and celebrated the holidays. This program is held each November with two sessions, each 75 minutes long, beginning at 9:00 and 10:30. The students participate in four stations including Butter Churning, Colonial Dress-Up, Weaving or Spinning, and Open Hearth or Colonial Garden.

We allow approximately 40 students per session so that they can be divided into small groups of 10 and have hands-on experiences at the different stations.
