The Beaufort Historic Site includes several historic buildings to choose from to create a customized Buildings Tour. These include:

Leffers Cottage: Visit a primitive home built by Samuel Leffers, Beaufort's first schoolmaster, in 1778. See how his family would have lived, especially interesting is the collection of early cookware.

Old Jail: Built of brick walls 28 inches thick, this jail was constructed in 1829. Students observe that the jailer lived in the same building as the prisoner and hear stories about some of Beaufort's criminals.

Apothecary Shop: Some Beaufort residents can still remember when Dr. Davis ran this drug store and doctor's office. Equipped with medical instruments, books, and hundreds of medicine vials, the Apothecary c. 1859 illustrates early medical practices.

County Courthouse: This restored one-room Courthouse of 1796 captivates the imagination as it depicts the simplicity of the early legal system.

Colonial Games: Students learn how children played in the colonial and Victorian eras.
