To assist you in seeing all the stops on the tour, shuttle transportation will be available during both days of the tour.

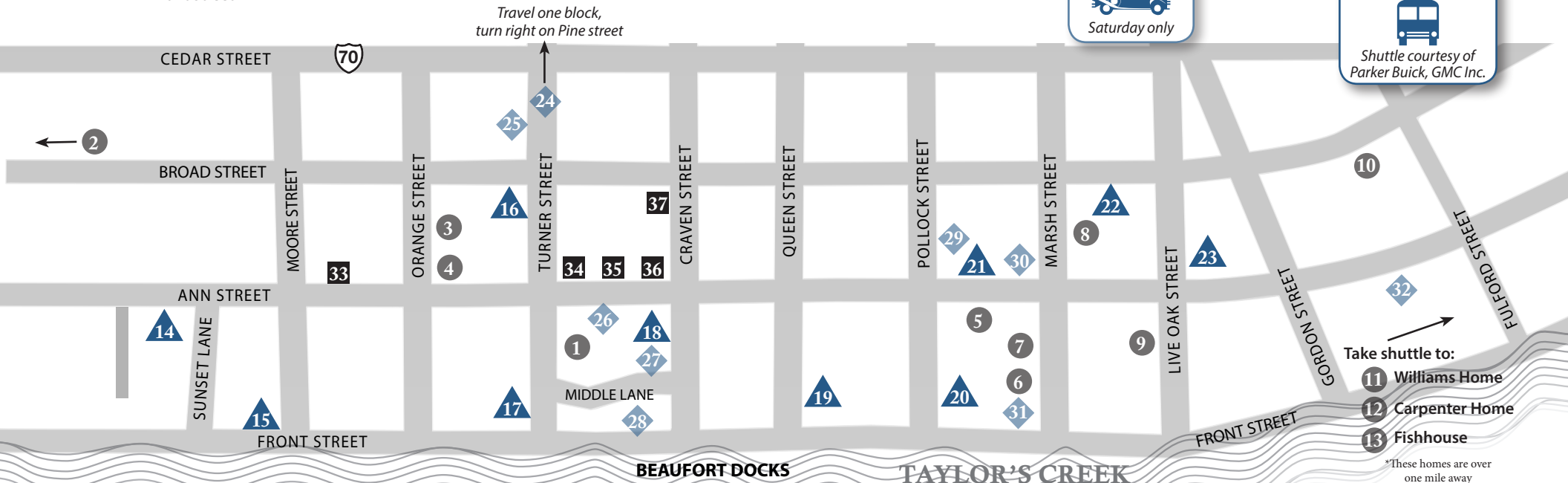
