

Janet Jaworski

attie King Davis Art Gallery welcomes artist Janet Jaworski as featured artist for June and July, as well as the Beaufort Historical Association's featured artist for the 63rd Annual Old Homes Tour. No stranger to the gallery or the Beaufort community, Janet's pieces have been featured in the gallery and fellow artists have been mentored or influenced by her.

Janet has been painting for over 40 years, most recently creating colorful oil paintings in Eastern North Carolina. Her work showcases the local beauty of wildlife, seascapes, waves, and boats, stamped with her unique and vibrant style. When her husband relocated to Carteret County for work, they were struck by the natural beauty of the area. Many of his photographs are the starting point for her paintings. Janet's style embodies her vibrant personality and love of color. "I strive to create my interpretation of local beauty with motion and color rather than simply an image of a tumbling wave or a soaring bird. I want to portray realism with a twist of abstraction within the shapes and forms on the canvas." Janet has been an active member of the artistic community since

moving to Carteret County. Prior to this she was an art director and graphic designer for many years. She has been associated with the Arts Council of Carteret County, the Mattie King Gallery locally and the Worcester Art Museum. Janet and her husband David opened Impressions Art Gallery and Studio in Morehead City. She has taken joy in promoting emerging artists and displaying their coastal creations. When asked about her favorite accomplishments, she said, "bringing people joy. Once a painting is finished, it has a life of its own."

• "Food is love. Flowers are jewels. No good party is complete without both. Come to think of it, no good life is either."


• "I have found that anything I need to accomplish can be done with a basket of muffins, a warm chicken potpie or a delicious dinner party meal."
